The Cyber Service Academy scholarship program provides scholarships for students pursuing degrees in cybersecurity and related fields in exchange for service in Department of Defense or Intelligence Community cybersecurity roles after graduation.

SCHOLARSHIP STUDENTS RECEIVE:

- ✓ Full tuition for the following academic year
- ✓ Stipends for books, a computer, and housing
- ✓ DoD internships
- ✓ Guaranteed post-graduation employment



ELIGIBILITY:

You must be:

- 18 years of age or older
- A citizen of the United States
- Enrolled in or applying to universities designated as National Centers of Academic Excellence in Cybersecurity and pursuing a course of study in one of the scientific, technical, or managerial disciplines related to cyber

You must have completed:

- The first year of an associate's degree; or
- The first two years of an undergraduate degree program; or
- A bachelor's degree, or a master's degree
